Have you done all that needs to be done – reported community service, let CAP know which colleges have accepted you and where you plan to attend, applied for ALL the scholarships you qualify for, taken those ACT/SAT tests necessary to qualify for Bright Futures, colleges, and scholarships?

Congratulations to our National Merit Finalists! Natalie Asorey, Caroline Mitchell, Andres T. Rivero, and Alice Shen. We are so very proud of your accomplishment!

All the financial aid workshops for seniors have been completed! Can you believe we have moved into the 21<sup>st</sup> century? ALL seniors had the opportunity to start their own Financial Aid (FAFSA) application ONLINE and only have to complete it at home once they have their parent's financial information. **We suggested the deadline date of February 14<sup>th</sup> to insure the availability of all funds but it's still not too late to apply. We have received recent information from colleges saying they will run out of financial aid monies much earlier this year!!**

As of December 1, the 2010-2011 Bright Futures application was online. You have until the end of the school academic year to apply for BF but please apply NOW and update as the year progresses. The website is:

It has been proven that taking the test at your "home school" usually equates to a higher test score. **PLEASE** – all juniors sign up immediately for the June 12<sup>th</sup> testing and start studying now! Our Code # is: 162210!.

National Testing Day! Not sure whether to take the ACT or the SAT? On National Testing Day, they will offer a **FREE** practice SAT exam on **Saturday March 20<sup>th</sup>** & a **FREE** practice ACT exam on **Sunday March 21<sup>st</sup>**. Then on **March 27<sup>th</sup> & 28<sup>th</sup>** get your personal, detailed score report & work with instructors to answer all your questions & develop your prep plan! **The June 12<sup>th</sup> ACT exam will be administrated here at Gables as we have just announced! Please plan to take the test at our school!!**

You have the choice whether to take the writing option or not with the ACT. Please check with each of the colleges you are considering applying to, to see if they require this test or you can go to ACT.org, enter the college name and it will give you that information. Please note there is an additional cost of \$15.00 for the writing test.

(Some colleges accept the ACT in place of the SAT Subject Tests so check with ALL the schools you are considering to check on their requirements.)

**VERY IMPORTANT INFORMATION: OUR STATE UNIVERSITITES ARE NOW REQUIRING THE WRITING PORTION OF THE ACT!**

The SAT, as well as most subject tests, will be given on all dates except March 13. Only the SAT will be given on that date. There are additional costs for the Subject tests. You can take up to 3 Subject tests in one sitting.

**Criteria:** Senior; planning a career in journalism, broadcasting or mass communications

**Value:** (1) @ \$1,000

**2. Name: Judge Sidney M. Aronovitz Memorial Scholarship**

**Criteria:** Senior; minority; planning to continue their education through 4 years; GPA of 3.0 or higher

### **2010 Jeanette A. Gill Annual Scholarship Award**

**Criteria:** Female high school senior of Black/African-American descent; excels in scholarship, leadership & service & possess good character with high ideals; attendance at a historically black college/university is mandatory

**Deadline:** March 17<sup>th</sup>

**Value:** yearly stipend of \$2,000 for not more than four years

Winners will be announced on or before May 14<sup>th</sup>. Finalists will be invited to a breakfast & oral interview session on April 17<sup>th</sup>

### **Clara B. Knight Scholarship**
